



Policy Panel: Cities and Forests

The municipality of Manaus is a symbol of the low priority given to the socio-environmental agenda when it comes to public policies for cities in the Brazilian Amazon. The context is aggravated when considering the representativeness and participation of social movements in the process of formulating policy proposals. Thus, the project "Policy Panel: Cities and Forests" sought to promote the construction of a digital platform for monitoring proposals on key themes related to the socio-environmental and climate agenda, combining the creation of spaces for debate and actively contributing to the formulation of policies.

Stages of the project






Components

Component #1. Advocacy on socio-environmental public policies

Goal: Promote active monitoring of socio-environmental public policy proposals

Historical mapping of socio-environmental policy proposals for the city of Manaus

- Mapping of the legislative production of the city of Manaus;
- Training the technical team through participatory workshops;

| Results

REUSA - REDENÇÃO

The workshops at REUSA - Redenção were held from October 2nd to 10th and were attended by 15 women. The methodology used was that of [Politize](#). In the 1st stage, knowledge about non-violent communication (CNV), public policies, democracy and political participation were shared and discussed with the attendants. In the 2nd stage, the Canvas of Public Policies and Implementation Strategies were built.

PARQUE DAS TRIBOS

The workshops at Parque das Tribos were held from October 2nd to 10th and were attended by 15 female community leaders. In the neighborhood, knowledge about non-violent communication, public policies, democracy and political participation was presented and discussed with the attendants. Then, there was an explanation to the participants on the subject during the systematization of opinions, points of convergence and divergence for the construction of the Canvas of Public Policies.

Survey "What do people from Manaus think about the environment?"

Are the people from Manaus in favor of new Conservation Units (CUs)? And what do they think about sustainable development?

In a survey carried out in partnership with Action Pesquisas de Mercado, in April 2021, 1.018 residents of the largest city in the Amazon were interviewed in order to identify the population's priorities in relation to the environment. The result shows that the vast majority of Manaus' residents support the conservation of the standing forest.

Standing forest
72,6%

of the people interviewed indicate that if conserved, the Amazon increases their quality of life



Green Areas
66,8%

Consider that urban green areas positively influence the daily life of the city




Fires
